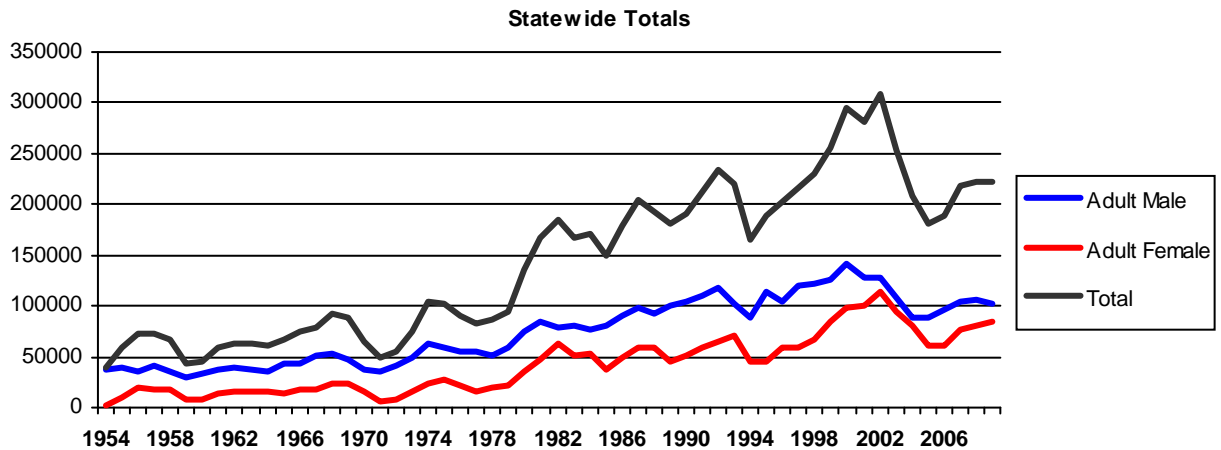

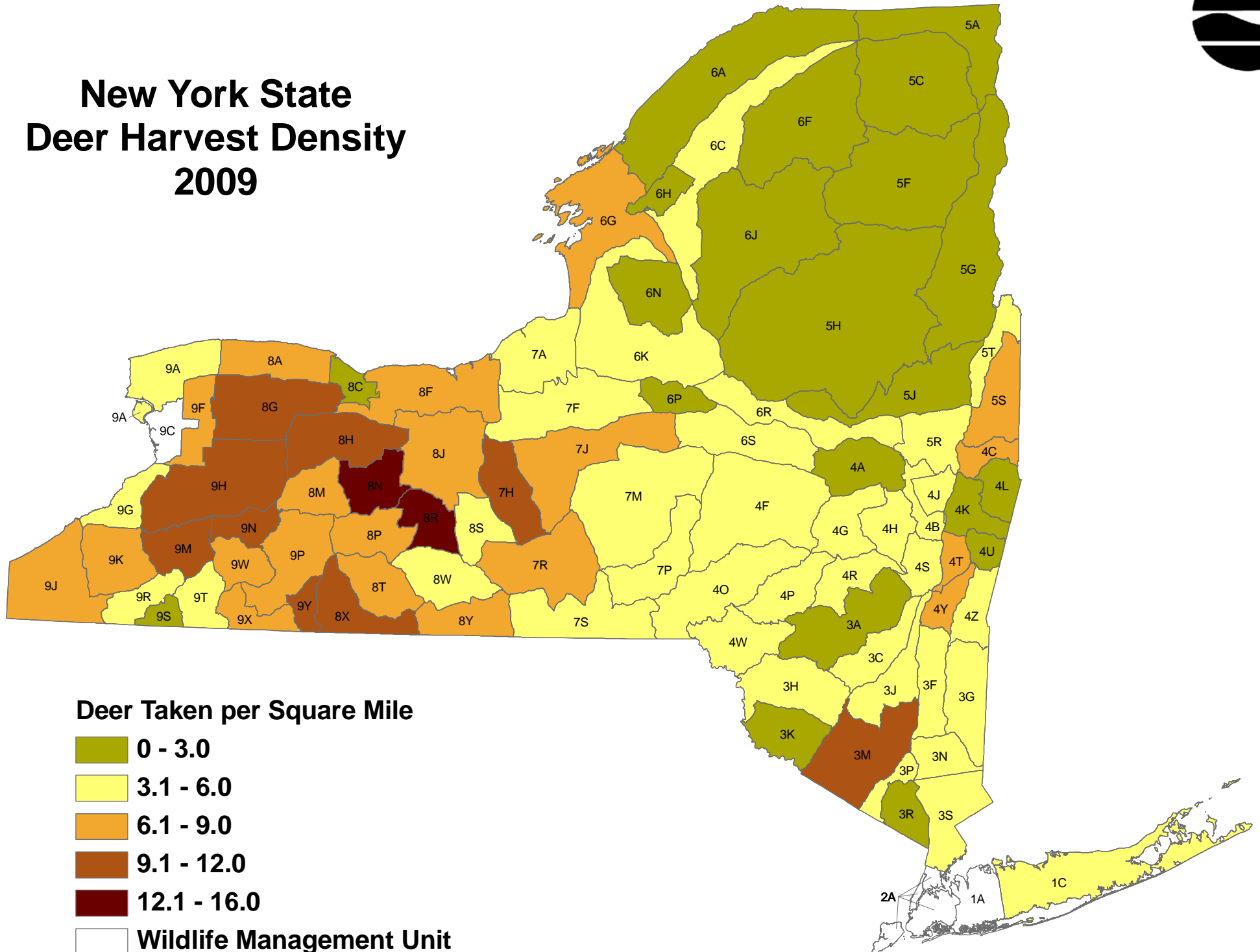

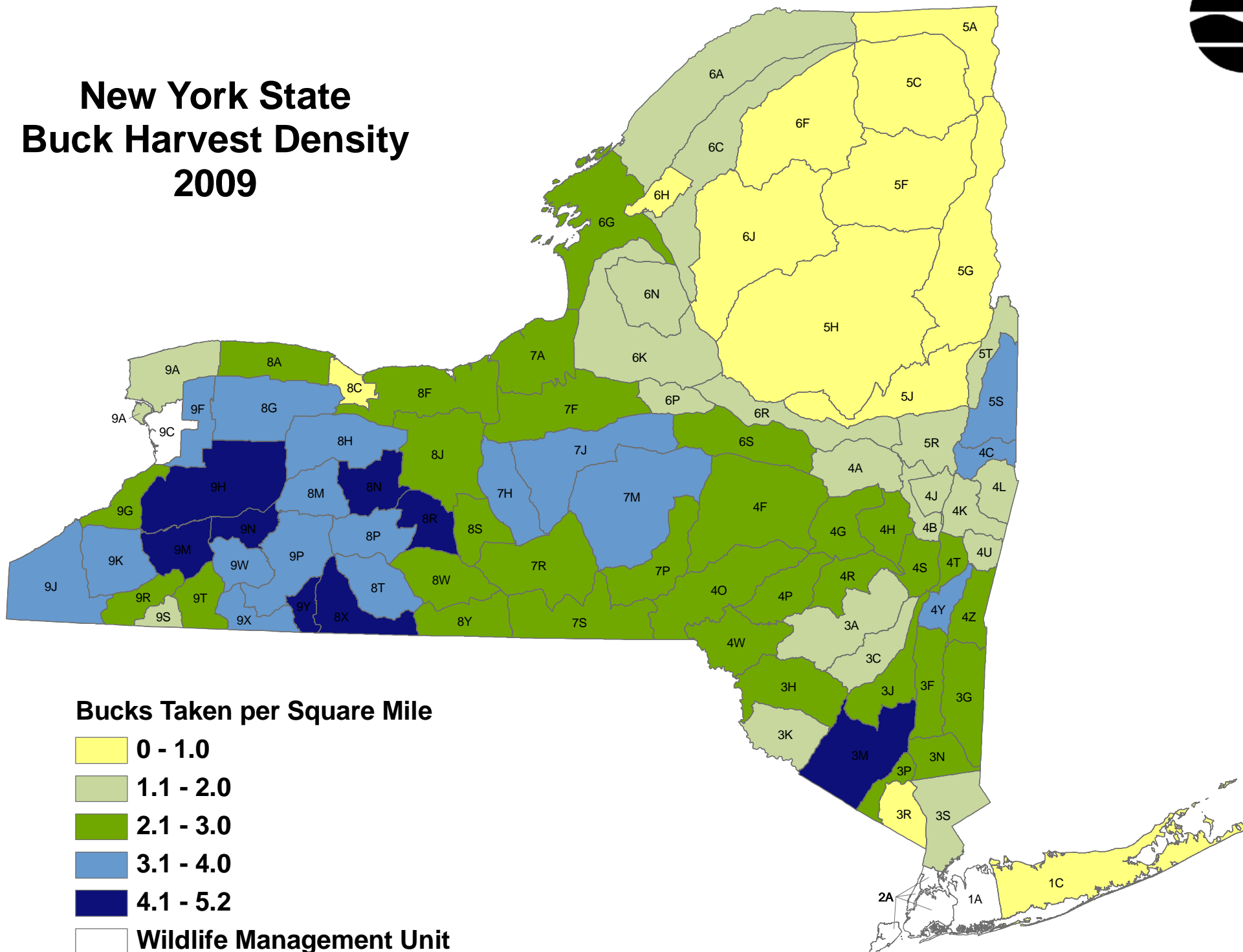


# New York State Deer Harvest Density 2009





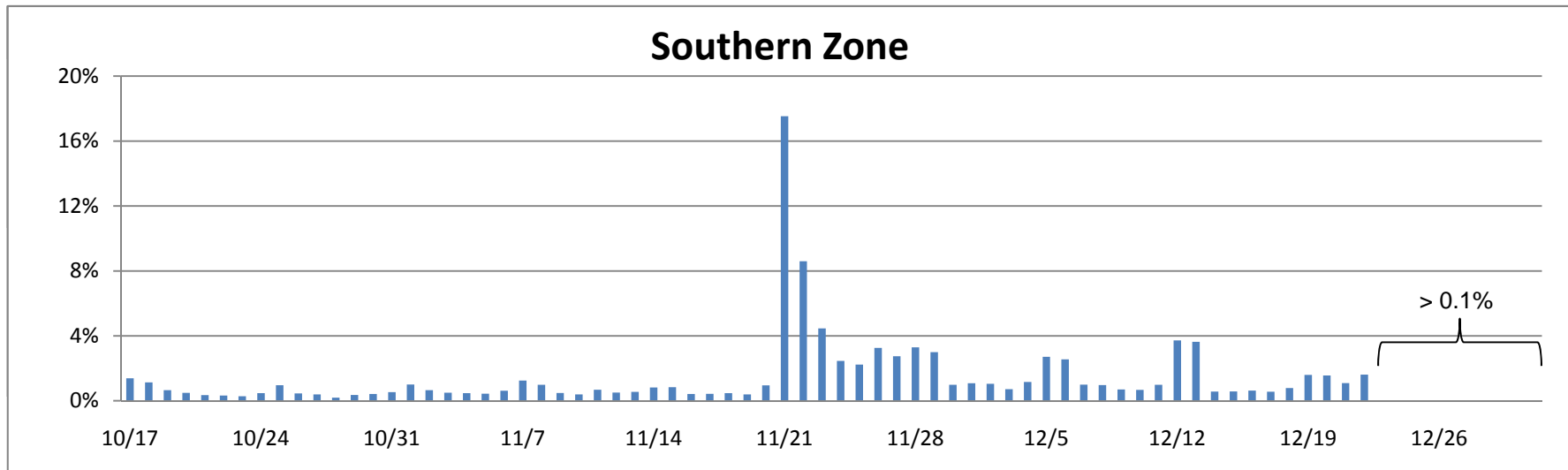
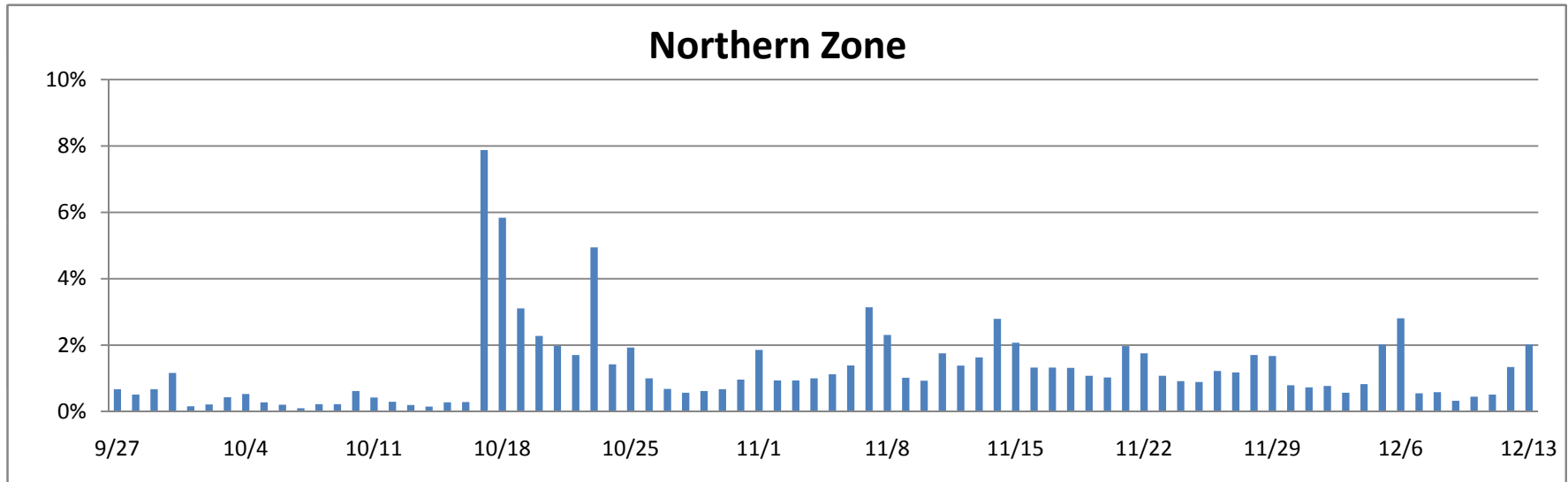
# New York State Buck Harvest Density 2009







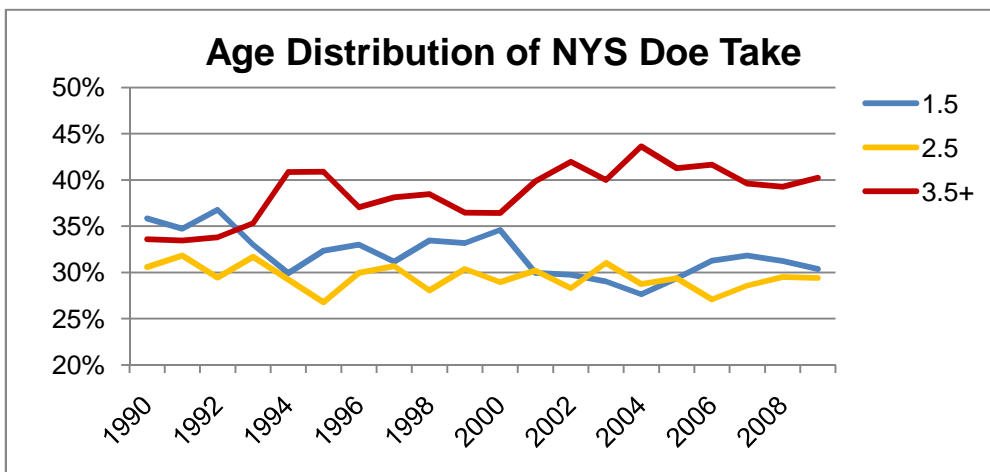
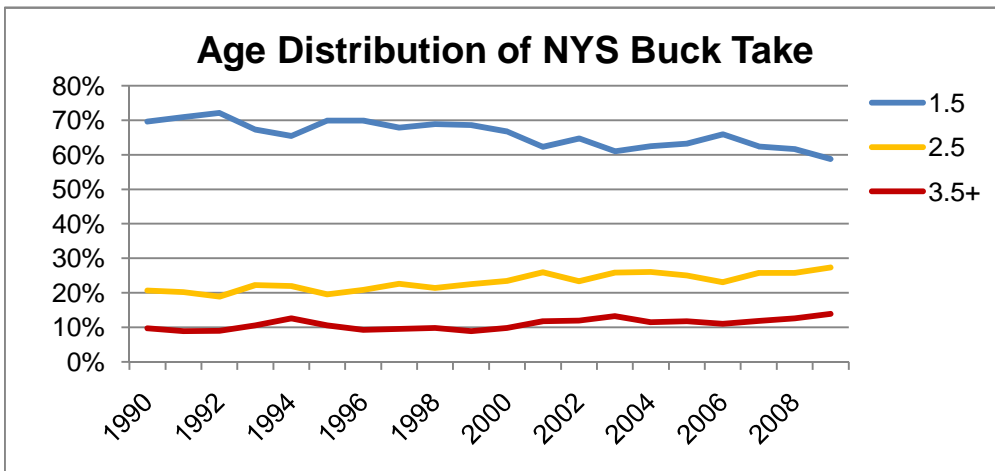
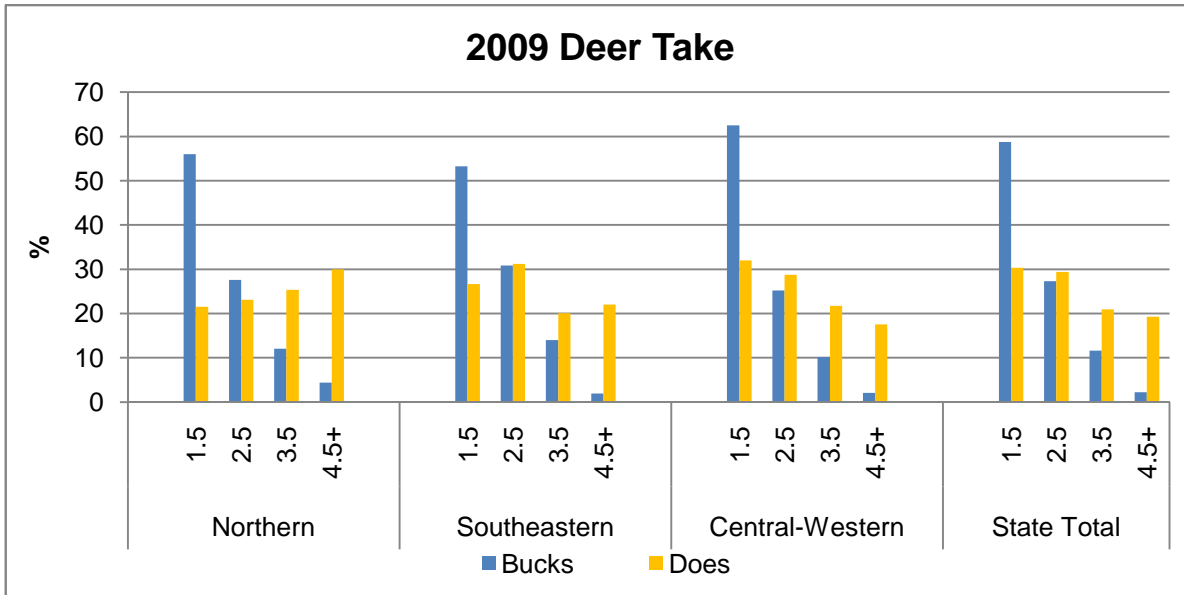
# New York State Reported Deer Take by Day 2009

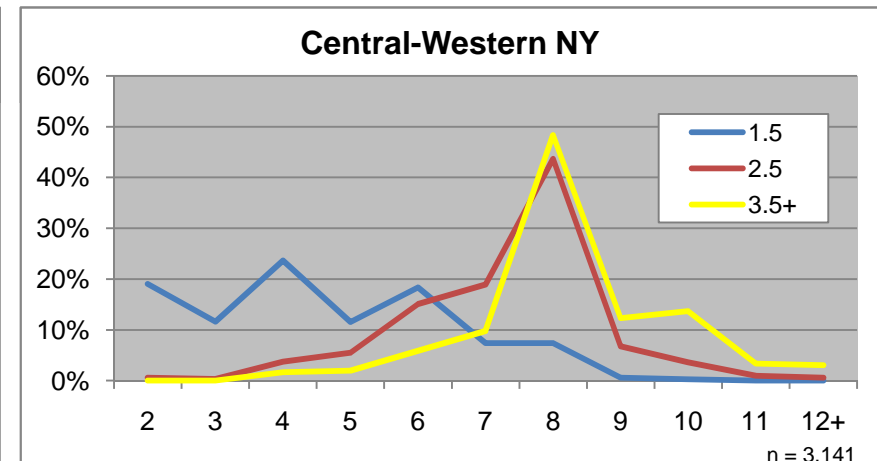
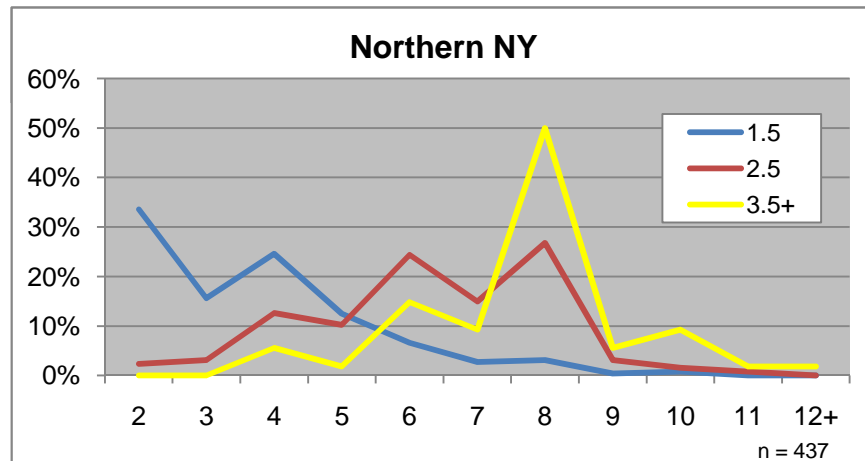
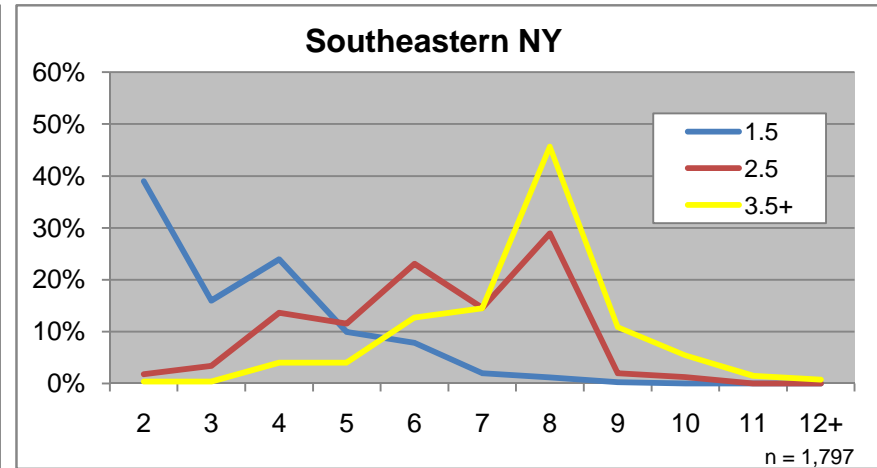
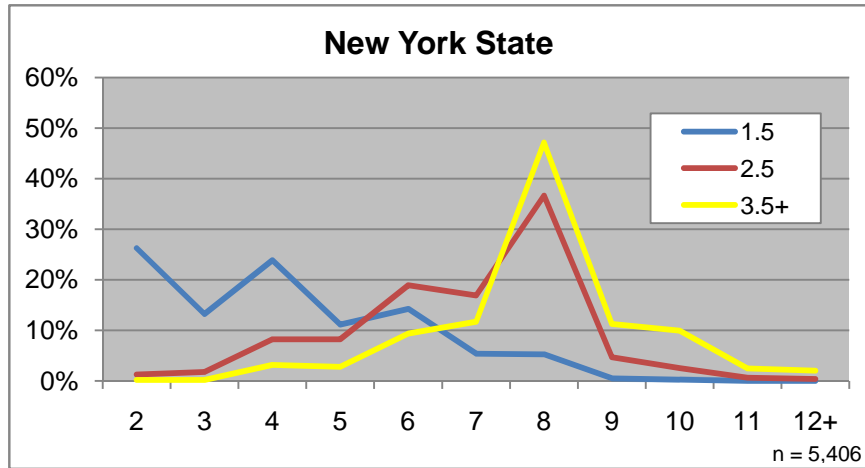
## New York State Age Distribution of Deer Harvest

The Buck Take Objective (BTO) for a WMU represents the number of antlered bucks expected to be harvested per square mile when the deer population is at the desired level. BTOs are based upon recommendations made by Citizen Task Forces in each WMU. BTOs are not the estimated take for a particular hunting season but rather help guide management efforts to adjust local deer populations. DEC biologists use the annual buck harvest as a gauge of population size and its relationship to the desired population level.

\* Buck take in many Adirondack and highly urban/suburban WMUs is not a strong index to the overall population size due to low hunter density and the relative importance of other mortality sources such as winter kill and collisions with vehicles. Thus, no Buck Take Objective has been established for these units.
